

Peek-a-Boo Slider Card

This design by Sandy Hancock (Pic at Bottom of Tutorial)

You will need five pieces of card stock plus decoration for this type of card.



1. The fifth piece is a 5 1/4\" x 4\" piece of Designer Series Paper(DSP). I'm using the Delightful Daisy DSP.
2. Layer the DSP onto the 5 1/2\" x 4 1/4\" Night of Navy c/s.
3. Take the 2\" Circle Punch and push it all the way into the c/s from the top and also line it up evenly with the right side of the c/s. Then punch. (Pic 5)




4. HOLD(DO NOT ADHERE) the punched out front of the card over the 8 1/2\" x 4 1/4\" Night of Navy c/s that has been folded in half. You can see that the open edge is at the right.
5. Draw a circle through the 2\" open with a pencil.
6. Pic 6 shows that I have already pushed the 2\" circle punch all the way in from the top again JUST ON THE NIGHT OF NAVY C/S and punched out another hole.

7. Then HOLD only the two circles like you see if pic 6 over the bottom part of the folded card and punch a 3rd 2" circle.



So now we have three 2" circles: 1 in the DSP (front panel of the card) and one in each side of the folded 8 1/2" x 4 1/4" Night of Navy c/s. NOTHING IS ATTACHED YET.

8. Add Tear & Tape to the 1/4" folds of the two pieces of white c/s.



9. Add the 3" white piece to the left side of the front panel.



10. Add the 5 3/4" white panel to the back side of the folded Night of Navy c/s. Lay it down on the Silicone mat to put the two pieces together just like I show above. Now you have the two white pieces of c/s attached to the two blue pieces of c/s. (pic on left)



11. The circle on the inside will need to be a little larger to accommodate the “Hugs” from the Lovely Words, so simply choose a Layering Circle that is large enough. Place it over the existing circle and cut it out. Move it away from the right edge of the card.
12. The card on the top is the finished card. You can see that the 2” circle below is not large enough. It doesn’t matter where you cut the larger circle as long as it fits OUTSIDE of the 2” circle as you see in the second card below.



13. Put adhesive all over the top of the folded 4 ¼” square piece of c/s.



14. Then place the front of the card with the DSP over it and press it into place to attach. Pic below on the left.



15. Now you have the two pieces connected and they will look like the pic above on the right.

16. Close the card and stamp the saying right through the window. Be sure to clean the ink off of the acrylic block (which I didn't do-dangerous!) Pic below.



17. Cut out "Hugs" with the Lovely Words Framelit and snip out the word "hugs". Place the "Hugs" through the circle and adhere it to the white c/s in the back.
18. Cut out a white frame using the Layering Circle Framelit that you just used plus one a little larger to get the frame.



19. Punch out 6 white daisies. Put them together with whatever you like to use.
20. Run a piece of Daffodil Delight c/s through the Softly Falling Embossing Folder to get the little bumps and then punch out a 1/2" circle for the center of each daisy.
21. I mounted the daisies on the front of the card with one dimensional which I placed right in the center on the back of the assembled daisy.
